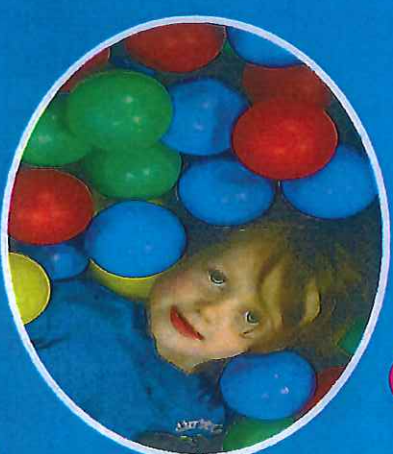

Breakfast & After School Club

Alongside our Pre-school we run a daily Breakfast and After School Club for children between two and thirteen years of age. Our Breakfast Club opens at 7:30am, a member of staff takes children attending Benwick Primary School over to school at 8:50am and waits with them until the school doors open, children attending the Pre-school session remain at play at the setting. We serve a FREE breakfast every morning between 7:30am and 8:15am where we serve a variety of cereals, toast with a selection of condiments, breakfast pastries such as croissants and pain au chocolat, yogurts, fruit juices and a daily selection of fruit.



Our afternoon Pre-school session merges into our After School Club from 3:00pm, with children staying on at the club remaining at play at the setting and a member of staff meeting the Primary School children from the school at our designated meeting place. The After School Club is open until 6:00pm; we offer a snack to all children in attendance at around 4:15pm with the option of dinner for an extra charge of £1.75.

A fun-packed Holiday Club!

Our Holiday Club is open during every scheduled school holiday apart from the Christmas break, 7:30am until 6:00pm daily. Full details of our holiday activities are produced every half term and made available to all our registered users, activities include arts and crafts, messy / sensory play, outside games, team games, cooking, experiments and so much more! Every holiday includes a trip out of the setting, with a trip a week planned in longer holidays such as the Easter and summer holidays. Trips out include cinema trips, outings to the farm or theme parks such as BeWILDerwood or Dinosaur Adventure Park, exploring local beaches and visiting the Science and Natural History Museums in London.

Meal Times: Throughout the day there are a variety of meal options / requirements. We serve a FREE breakfast every morning between 7:30am and 8:15am and then a fruit bowl is available for children to select from throughout the morning to have as a snack. Children attending the setting between 12:00pm and 1:00pm will require a packed lunch, we do suggest that this includes a healthy balance of lunchtime foods and do ask that they do not include any chocolate bars / sweets or soda / pop drinks. Children are encouraged to eat foods such as sandwiches, brioche, crackers etc. first before moving on to items such as yogurts, crisps, fruit etc. In the afternoon we then offer a snack to all children in attendance at around 4:15pm with the option of dinner for an extra charge of £1.75.
