<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Write using our topic of WWII as your inspiration! Your main character could be an evacuee, a survivor of the Blitz, a Jewish refugee or an ally spy!</p> <p>Your writing could be in the form of a story, a series of letters between two characters or a diary recount.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Find out the cost of rationed items. How much would you spend in a week?</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Can you write a message that when reflected in a mirror will make sense? Take photographs to prove it!</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Research a famous artist who was popular during WWII. Can you replicate their picture or create your own war-based picture?</p>	<p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Design and make a parachute for a soldier that would keep them safe.</p> <p>You could use a small figurine to test your parachute.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Research WWII music and find a song from the time to listen to and read the lyrics.</p> <p>Rewrite the lyrics linking to WWII or write a paragraph about what the song is saying about the war.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> <p>Visit a Museum or an Exhibition and take some photographs or write a review.</p>	<p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Read and review a war based book e.g.</p> <p>Have a look in the school library to see if you can find one!</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Create a map of the UK, labelling the countries and major cities that were under attack in WWII.</p> <p>You could do this by drawing the map with pencils and plotting boundaries of countries, counties and cities. Include where you live!</p>
