
A circus is a travelling group of performers, including acrobats, jugglers, clowns and animals. It is held in a big tent.

The circus is held in the big top, a large tent. Inside there is seating for the audience. The


performances happen in the ring, which is in the middle of the

The ringmaster introduces all of the circus acts.


They are the leader of the circus.

Sword swallowing is very dangerous and the performers have to train very hard to do this job without hurting themselves.




stilt wa
