<p>History Year 1</p> <p>Find out about trains throughout the ages and create a poster showing the different trains you have learnt about and write about each one.</p> <p>EYFS make a lego/construction model of a train from the past and send a photo of your model to our class Dojo page for us to see.</p>	<p>Rock Stars and counting maths Year 1</p> <p>TT Rock Stars Use Times Tables Rock Stars to practice your times tables ready to start our timed challenges and earn points!</p> <p>EYFS https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/3-5-years/counting Spend time with your child counting. This is an important early skill! Also give them an amount to count accurately eg if they are playing with lego ask them to make a certain height tower up to 20.</p>	<p>English Year 1 find out and research about a person in your family. Ask the adults about them, perhaps facetime an interview with them? Write a factual account about this special person in your life.</p> <p>EYFS Draw a member of your family. Label the picture and write some simple sentences about this special person.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p>Farmer grow the plants that we eat. What plants do we eat? Can you grow an edible plant at home? Describe what you would do to make sure that the plants you grow stay healthy and strong.</p> <p>Take a look at the food you have in the cupboard and find out what it looks like if it is grown eg flour...where does it come from? If cooking with your child talk about the ingredients and where they come from.</p>	<p>Maths Year 1</p> <p>Complete a survey or questionnaire that shows your families favourite plants or the plants in your garden. You can choose how to present your findings</p> <p>EYFS Use pictures to show your families favourite plants. Draw a picture for each persons like and match them to their name.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>If you have access to the internet ask you child to look at images from the artist Vincent Van Gogh. He used a specific style of mark making. See if your child can recreate a picture using either crayons, pencils or paint in lines like his style.</p> <p>If you cannot access his images see if your child can do a picture with only lines and no colouring in.</p>
<p>Reading Year 1</p> <p>Write a book review of a book you have read recently. Would you recommend it? Why/ Why not?</p> <p>EYFS Ask your child to pick their favourite book and talk to you about what they like about the story, what they dislike, what is happening and what could happen at the end.</p>	<p>Research/RE Year 1</p> <p>Find out about the Easter story and present this in a way of your choice. You could create a comic strip, re-enact the story and take pictures or write your version of the story.</p> <p>EYFS hear a version of the Easter story either online or read a version to your child. Ask your child to draw/ paint/ make a picture from the story. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/easter/easterstory.aspx</p>	<p>Geography Year 1</p> <p>Draw a map of your journey to school. Remember to include all the road names. Can you locate where any significant buildings are? Where your friends live? Where the park is?</p> <p>EYFS draw a pictorial map of your journey to school and label the places you see and know phonetically.</p>
