EYFS	Year 1
<p>Day 1</p> <p>With our EYFS children we would do these calculations practically. Remember to get them to count items and either add or take away amounts.</p> <p> $5+2+2=$ $8-5=$ $2+1+3=$ Share 4 between two people 5 Lots of 2 </p>	<p>Day 1</p> <p>With our Year 1 children some of these calculations can be done in their head. They might need practical amounts to help them or a number square or number line. They can use paper to work out their answer.</p> <p> $13+33=$ $10+11+12=$ $8 \times 10=$ $45-6=$ $\frac{1}{2}$ of 16 </p>
<p>Day 2</p> <p> $6+3=$ $4+3=$ $10-6=$ Share 10 between two people 4 Lots of 3 </p>	<p>Day 2</p> <p> $5 \times 10=$ 30 divided by 5 $5 \times 5=$ Half of 22 $1+ _ +8=19$ </p>
<p>Day 3</p> <p> $2+7=$ $6+4=$ $8-4=$ Share 9 between 3 people 2 lots of 4 </p>	<p>Day 3</p> <p> $9+8+10=$ Half of 16 $2 \times 6=$ 18 shared between 2 $5+10+ _ =20$ </p>
<p>Day 4</p> <p> $4+6=$ $2+8=$ $5-2=$ Share 8 between 2 people $10+5=$ </p>	<p>Day 4</p> <p> $2 \times 11=$ Half of 28 14 divided by 2 $30-20=$ $12+8+ _ =24$ </p>
<p>Day 5</p> <p>Order the numbers 0-20 and play hide a number for your child to work out.</p> <p>Write out numbers as you say them to 20 – have a number line in front of them. Listen to and watch some count to 20 and back to 0 songs.</p>	<p>Day 5</p> <p> Half of 14 $3+4+8=$ $10 \times 5=$ $50-18=$ 40 divided by 10 </p>
