Parents of Children on the SEND Register:

APDRs

Each term, teachers complete individual plans for children identified as having Special Educational Needs or Disabilities, these are known as APDRs (Assess, Plan, Do, Review). It is a "needs-led" response, meaning it is tailored to the individual child, ensuring that support is based on their specific, evolving requirements.

The school gathers information to understand your child's barriers to learning, strengths, and needs, sometimes external professionals' input (like a speech therapist, specialist teacher or psychologist) is used to support the plan. A small number of specific, measurable outcomes (SMART targets) are set along with how these will be addressed.

Your child's most recent plan is being sent home today in an envelope. Our next parents' evening, where this plan can be reviewed with you and new targets discussed, will be in April. However, if you have any questions about the plan before then, please do contact your child's class teacher.
