#### **Dear Parents & Carers**,

We have made it to half –term! The children and staff certainly deserve a rest, we hope you all have a lovely half-term break!

### Attendance:

We are all working really hard to make our school the best it can be, however our overall attendance figures are currently not high enough to be deemed good, (this is not related to Covid). The Local Authority are keen that we are stringent in our processes to monitor and address poor attendance, after all we all know school is where children learn best. Our attendance policy is available on our website.

#### A few reminders:

- Make routine dental and eye appointments **outside** of school time these will not be automatically authorised if routine and taken in school time.
- If you know your child will be absent for an appointment that **cannot be made outside of school time**, please request leave of absence BEFORE the appointment and provide evidence of the appointment.
- Lateness: currently the last time slot for arrival is 8.55 9am. A late mark will be issued between 9-9.10 and any arrivals after 9.10am will be marked as unauthorised. The local authority may choose to fine for persistent absence, including those as a result of lateness.
- Penalty notices, £60 per parent (rising to £120 after 21 days), can be issued by the local authority for attendance below 90% and holidays, or suspected holidays, taken in term time.
- If your child is too ill for school, please let the school office know before 9.30am
- Late nights, birthdays, ill parents/ siblings are not reasons for absence that can authorised

### Uniform & presentation:

The vast majority of children wear school uniform proudly, please support us by ensuring your child wears correct school uniform every day, it really does help them come to school in the right frame of mind for learning and supports good behaviour. Please remember that Nail polish and temporary tattoos are not permitted and children with long hair should wear this tied back for health and safety reasons as well as preventing the transmission of headlice.
