#### Scooters and bikes:

We do not allow children to ride their bikes/scooters along the path to the playground (next to the village hall) or on the playground for safety reasons, this includes pre-school children. Please support us in reminding your children of this on arrival/departure from school – thank you.

## Attendance:

We have some children in school who have fabulous attendance, some even 100%, and are making fabulous progress as a result. Unfortunately, we are increasingly worried about the low attendance of many of our children and the detrimental impact this has on their learning and social skills. We are well aware of outbreaks of covid and chickenpox etc, and absence for these illnesses is unavoidable, however there are many occasions when reasons supplied for absence are not acceptable.

We cannot support families where we have concerns over the legitimacy of the reason being provided or if evidence suggests that we are not being told the truth. Where I have concerns over the legitimacy of a reason being provided, then I may take the decision to automatically 'unauthorise' absences and parents will be made aware of this with the consequence of a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) possibly being issued by the Local Authority.

There is currently a formal consultation in place nationally to review attendance regulations as set by the DfE and this will include, from September, a more consistent national approach to the issuing of fixed penalty notices to parents. As a school we are doing our very best to offer a high quality curriculum and support every child to achieve their potential and we cannot do this if they are not in school; every day counts right up to the end of term. Please support us in supporting your child by making sure they are in school, on time, every day possible. **Thank you** 

## **Sports Day/School PE Kits:**

The children mostly looked fabulous and ready for races on Sports Day, it was a super event, we were so proud of all our children; the positivity, resilience and support showed for one another was wonderful! **Thank you for supporting us by attending!** 

We have noticed a minority of children are not wearing school sports kits. We know that over the year children grow and towards the end of the year no longer fit in their school PE Kit. Football strips etc should NOT be worn for PE/games and if children have grown out of kit should wear a plain (preferably white) t-shirt and dark unbranded shorts/tracksuit bottoms until new kit is purchased for the new school year. PE Kits are part of our uniform expectation and help to create the correct attitudes for learning and participation, they are not expensive if bought from supermarkets and do not have to be branded with our logo.
