





Autumn Term 2 Homework Menu – Whole School

In addition to individual class set homework which is a minimum of: daily reading, spellings and x tables/number fact learning, a menu of optional homework is available for those wishing to do more (although we would like everyone to complete at least 2 over the half term). This half-term we have set a whole school menu and the tasks can be completed at any level from Reception to Year 6, this means siblings can work on things side by side at home too. The tasks are purposefully quite open ended so that children can work on them in a way that employs their interests or skills. We will be reviewing our homework policy in the new year and will be asking for parents and pupil views then.

<p>Reading: Write a book review of a book you have read from our library. Our new system allows for reviews by children to be uploaded, so yours could end up here.</p> <p>Younger children: Draw a picture of your favourite character and write some words/sentences to describe them.</p>	<p>Maths: 'Figure Me Out' – take part in the whole school competition during maths week. All information has been emailed to parents.</p> 	<p>PSHE/Writing: Choose one of school values (Community, Resilience, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty). Draw a picture to represent this value in action and /or write a poem/letter/newspaper report to demonstrate this. e.g. a fictional newspaper report could tell the story of someone helping their community during a disaster.</p>
<p>Art: Go on an Autumn Walk and gather leaves. Make a piece of art using these leaves.</p> 	<p>History/RE: Find out about a Christmas tradition in other countries now or in the past. You can produce some writing using traditional methods or ICT or make a Christmas decoration to show this.</p>	<p>PE/Dance: Find a piece of music you like, create a sequence of dance moves and teach someone else. This can be as short or long as you like!</p>
