

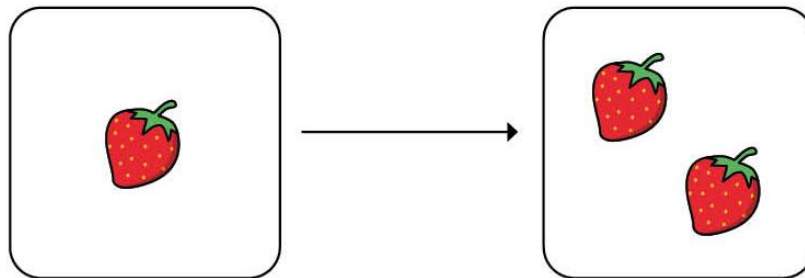
Doubles Day 3,4 and 5.
