Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope you have all had a lovely summer and are looking forward to the children being back at school. We are certainly looking forward to the buzz of a full school once again, and I know that we will all soon get used to the new routines and procedures.

I know that children and adults may feel different levels of excitement and anxiety about coming back to school and this is completely understandable. Please remember to show your children the staff videos on our class pages and talk to them about what to expect. My letter sent at the end of July details Questions and Answers you and your children may have, this can still be found on our website homepage in latest news, however as promised I have included a few of the most essential points below:

- Children in Years 1 to 6 will start back at school on Monday 7th September.
- The new children who are joining Reception will start school on Monday 7th September at 1.15pm.
- All children to wear full uniform. Children will need their PE kits straight away.
- Children must only bring a named: water bottle, PE kits, lunch box/bag.
- Staggered start and finish times will be applied for all children using surnames. 1 parent only to drop off/collect please.
- All adults must always maintain social distancing whilst waiting for collection/drop off
- Adults waiting to collect children from Doves, Owls & Swans should wait in the main carpark.
- Parents/Carers may only come in to the school building with a previously arranged appointment, please contact the school office.
- It is essential that all children arrive and leave at their designated start or finish time.
- Children do not have to socially distance (2m) within their class bubbles but 'no physical contact' will be expected.
- Staff will aim to keep a 2 metre distance from children whenever possible
- Children who are ill should stay at home (please contact us to let us know), children with symptoms of Covid 19 will be sent home immediately.
