We always deal with incidents of behaviour, but due to confidentiality, other children or parents at home may not know what we have done, but please rest assured we take behaviour incidents very seriously and deal with them proportionately, but mostly privately. We thank you for your understanding and support with this, however if you have concerns do share them with us and speak with your child's class teacher in the first instance.

We are still in the process of arranging our Christmas activities. Unfortunately this year, there will not be a nativity in its usual format and we are not able to hold a Christmas Fayre as I had hoped we would.
