Also give them an amount to count accurately eg if they are playing with lego ask them to make a certain height tower up to 20.</p>	<p>English Write a diary entry about what you have been doing in lock down. You could make a comic strip of what you have been doing at home. EYFS Draw a comic strip picture for each part of what you have been doing in lock down. Write a simple sentence under each image.</p>
<p>Science Properties of materials See if you can collect a variety of pieces of different items. Which ones do you think will sink and which ones will float? Make a prediction chart before you explore the items and see which ones sink and which float. Then talk about what you have found out. Year 1 children can write down what they have found out as a conclusion.</p>	<p>ICT Log into purple mash with your child and continue to explore the range of programmes and activities there. Using different programmes for different purposes is an important skill for you child to learn.</p> 	<p>Art Look at the puppet plan you made for your puppet last week. See if you can find some material to cut out as the outline of your puppet, make two pieces the same. See if you can stick or sew or draw details onto your puppet. Then try to sew or glue the two sides together and put some cotton wool or other item inside to make your puppets stomach. We look forward to seeing your finished puppets.
