Children In Need:

Our children In Need Day raised £98.00, thank you for supporting this wonderful charity.

Dental statistics:

Did you know? In 2017-2018 the NHS spent £38.9million on 45,000 child hospital admissions for dental treatment under general anaesthetic. Dental decay is the number one reason for elective hospital admissions for children! Dental decay is a largely preventable disease, 26% of 5 year olds will start school with decay affecting 3-4 teeth. 2019 local statistics 25% of 5 year olds in Fenland presented at the dentist with decayed, missing or filled teeth.

Healthy snacks & drinks:

We are a healthy eating school, please only send healthy snacks for breaktimes such as fruit, cereal bars (no nuts) or cheese and crackers. Cookies, crisps, cake, chocolate bars are <u>not</u> allowed. KS1 are provided with a piece of fruit daily by school.
